

Programming Bellwork

Monday

1. **Ctrl-Shift-Drag:** Ctrl-drag will copy an item and holding the Shift key will constrain the movement to only horizontal or only vertical.

2. **Side Transition:** Determines the effects in the display that occur as you move from one slide to another in PowerPoint.

Tuesday

1. **Visual Basic:** This is a fifth generation programming language (5GL). 5GLs contain visual tools that help develop a program.

2. **Msg Box:** This indicates that the action performed when a button is clicked will be a pop-up box with a message of the programmer's choice written in it.

Wednesday

1. **Alt-Q:** This is the keyboard shortcut to save and close programming work in Visual Basic.

2. **Control Button:** This is a programming element that allows you to have a button on the screen which can be activated by mouse click and produce a variety of actions. You choose the action and program it into the button.

Thursday

1. **slideshowwindows(1).view.next:** Visual basic command that programs a button to take the user to the next slide in sequence in the slide show.

2. **slideshowwindows(1).view.first:** Visual basic command that programs a button to take the user to the first slide in the slide show from any slide.

Friday

1. **Hyperlink:** A link that allows users to jump from one slide to another in PowerPoint or to link to an outside document or web page.

2. **Custom Animation:** Special visuals or sound effects added to text or an object on a PowerPoint slide.
